PUBLIC COMMENT

Shannan Clevenger, Chief Operating Officer noted the Narcan® machine available in the [Hillsdale] office lobby, which will soon also include fentanyl test strips. Also relayed was the recently found data that, for every staff opening in the mental health system nationwide, there are .4 people available. Further mentioned was that individuals can create a password for LifeWays' Electronic Medical Record (EMR) in order to access their records. Lastly, spoke to the CCBHC providing more than just the nine core services, under which some consumers may be covered.
